Dear Friend,

One of my favorite verses from the Old Testament is,

Psalm 107:20 KJV He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

It has always fascinated me that when God delivered His people from slavery in Egypt, He also prospered them and healed every single one of them.

Psalm 105:37 KJV He brought them forth also with silver and gold: <u>and there was not one feeble person</u> <u>among their tribes</u>.

Exodus 12:37 tells us that there were about six hundred thousand men in the congregation that left Egypt, not counting women and children. I think it would be fair to estimate that at least one million people were in that group. They had been in slavery for hundreds of years. They had endured back-breaking labor every day, meager food supplies, and very poor health care. I wonder how many of the elderly among them had tooth decay, arthritis, and many other maladies, not only from old age but also from having been slaves their whole lives.

But God sent His Word through His servant Moses, and instantaneously there was not a single person among them who was feeble with any malady at all. What a perfect illustration of the healing power of God's Word. Moses was a prophet, so the Word of God spoken by Him would be included in this section of the book of Hebrews.

Hebrews 1:1-2 KJV God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, [2] Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;

Who is this Son? The apostle John tells us He is the embodiment of the Word itself.

John 1:1-3,14 KJV In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. [2] The same was in the beginning with God. [3] All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. [14] And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

First God sent His Word by the prophets. Then He sent His Word embodied in human flesh. The Word sent "among us" in bodily form continued to heal all that were oppressed of the devil.

Acts 10:36-38 KJV The word which God sent unto the children of Israel, preaching peace by Jesus Christ: (he is Lord of all:) [37] That word, I say, ye know, which was published throughout all Judaea, and began from Galilee, after the baptism which John preached; [38] How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

But being "among us" was not good enough for God. God wanted the Word to dwell "in us." That is the great mystery of the gospel, that it is now possible for God to dwell "in us."

### Colossians 1:27 KJV To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is <u>Christ in you</u>, the hope of glory:

God has sent Christ, the Messiah, His Son, the Word ... in ... YOU! He has sent His Word in you. What does the Word do? What has the Word always done? It heals all infirmities. Healing is dwelling on the inside of you right now!

I will be the first to admit, it sure isn't automatic. When you are suffering from any sort of sickness, pain, injury of any kind ... everything in your body screams there is no Word healing on the inside of you at that moment. But if you are born again, Christ the Healer ... the living Word ... is in you. The Word is dwelling in your flesh right now. Jesus, who cannot lie. promised it would be so.

### John 14:21 KJV He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, <u>and will manifest myself to him.</u>

The Classic Amplified Bible brings out the nuances of the Greek language and lets us hear more accurately the fullness of what Jesus actually said,

# John 14:21 AMPC The person who has My commands and keeps them is the one who [really] loves Me; and whoever [really] loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I [too] will love him and will show (reveal, manifest) Myself to him. [I will let Myself be clearly seen by him and make Myself real to him.]

What a promise. The Word that was first spoken by the prophets and was then made flesh and dwelt "among us," is now living "in us." The Word does not change. He healed them all then. He heals them all now. What is the missing ingredient?

The simple answer is faith, but why is there such a lack of faith among God's people? Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God

#### Romans 10:17 KJV So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

God's people are being destroyed for a lack of knowledge. They have not been taught that God has sent His Word into them and healed them. The truth of the gospel has not been taught in its purity from most of pulpits of the world. Our "belief system" is based on a mixture of the Word of God, the world, and our own past history.

But Jesus promised those who would continue in His Word that we would know the truth, and the truth would make us free.

### John 8:31-32 KJV Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, <u>If ye continue in my word, then</u> are ye my disciples indeed; [32] And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

Not only did the Word "in us" set us free from the bondage of sin, but He set us free from sickness and disease, the near cousins of sin and death.

### Romans 8:2 KJV For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

He has sent His Word into us to heal us. Let us rise up and possess this portion of our inheritance also. Recently, during a time of prayer, the Lord spoke to me directly about Him being the Word in us. I have posted it for you at the end of this letter.

My words carry no less power than when I said for light to be. There are no facts that can stand before truth when truth is believed and spoken. I AM the truth. Believe on Me whom God has sent to abide in you. Speak only truth.
